

* 2012, ** 2011



Health Care Spending per Capita by Source of Funding, 2013 Adjusted for Differences in Cost of Living







Pharmaceutical Spending per Capita, 2013




Spending on Health Insurance Administration per Capita, 2013 Adjusted for Differences in Cost of Living


Total Hospital and Physician Costs, 2013

Physician Supply and Use, 2013






Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Machines per Million Population, 2013





Average Length of Stay for Hospital Acute Care, 2013




Hip Replacements per 100,000 Population, 2013


Flu Immunization Among Adults Age 65 or Older, 2013

Percent of population 15 years and older










Thirty-day Mortality After Admission to Hospital for Acute Myocardial Infarction, 2013

Age-sex standardised rate per 100 admissions of adults aged 45 years and over



Foreign Body Left in During Procedure, per 100,000 Hospital Discharges, 2013



Mortality Due to Cancer, 1995 to 2007


