









 Don't know











Likelihood of Employers' Changing Response to Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Benefit If Various Changes Occur, 2007*







Percentage of Employers Planning on Making Various Changes^ to Retiree Health Benefit in the Next Two Years




Percentage of Public Employers Familiar with GASB Regulations, 2007 vs. 2006*

Among Public Employers Familiar with GASB, Percentage Concerned About Financial Impact of Complying with GASB Regulations, 2007 vs. 2006*





Among Public Employers Familiar with GASB, Have or Will These Employers Make Various Changes to Retiree Health Benefits, 2007









Type of Health Plan with the Largest Number of Medicare-Age Retirees Enrolled, 2007*







Average Monthly Premiums for Medicare-Age Retirees in Largest Health Plan, Single Coverage, 2007





Average Annual Deductibles for Medicare-Age Retirees in Largest Health Plan, Single Coverage, 2007





Distribution of Type of Cost-Sharing for Office Visits for Medicare-Age Retirees in Largest Health Plan, 2007*





Average Annual Prescription Drug Deductibles for Medicare-Age Retirees in Largest Health Plan, 2007*








