

National Healthcare Disparities Report (NHDR)


- Snapshot of disparities in health care in America
- Quality + Access
- Variation across populations

Origin of National Healthcare Disparities Report

- Health and Human Services Secretary required to submit annual report to Congress:
 - National trends in health care quality (National Healthcare Quality Report)
 - Prevailing disparities in health care delivery as it relates to racial factors and socioeconomic factors in priority populations (National Healthcare Disparities Report)



Mandated by Congress in Healthcare Research and Quality Act (PL. 106-129)



Goals for Disparities Reports


Reports such as NHDR and the Commonwealth Fund Chartbook are important to showing disparities as quality issues that should be incorporated in QI efforts because they:

Reveal the biggest gaps in care
Show national and state trends
Help align measures across public and private quality initiatives

Progress is being made, but many of the biggest gaps remain

New in the 2007 NHDR

- Patient Centeredness: Diversity of the Registered Nurse Workforce, Focus on Health Literacy
- Priority Populations: Supplemental data for Asians and Hispanics from the California Health Interview Survey (CHIS)
- Priority Populations: People With Disabilities and Special Health Care Needs, Adults With Disabilities



NHDR Findings

- Over 60% of disparities in quality of care have stayed the same or worsened for Blacks, Asians and poor populations
- Nearly 60% of disparities have stayed the same or worsened for Hispanics
- For Blacks, Asians, Hispanics and poor populations, disparities in about half the core measures of access to care are lessening







Disparities in health care quality and access are staying the same or increasing
