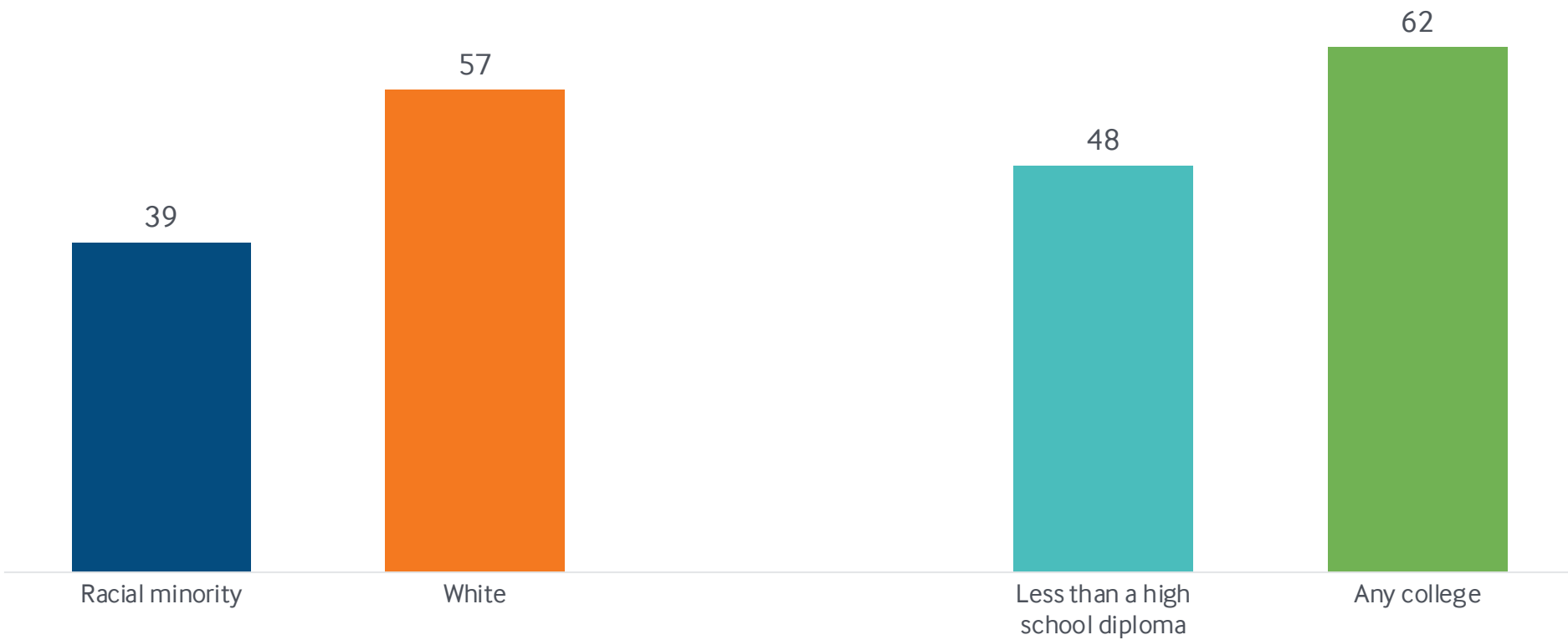


# Share of Kentuckians in Medicaid Who Have Heard About Work Requirements, by Race and Education

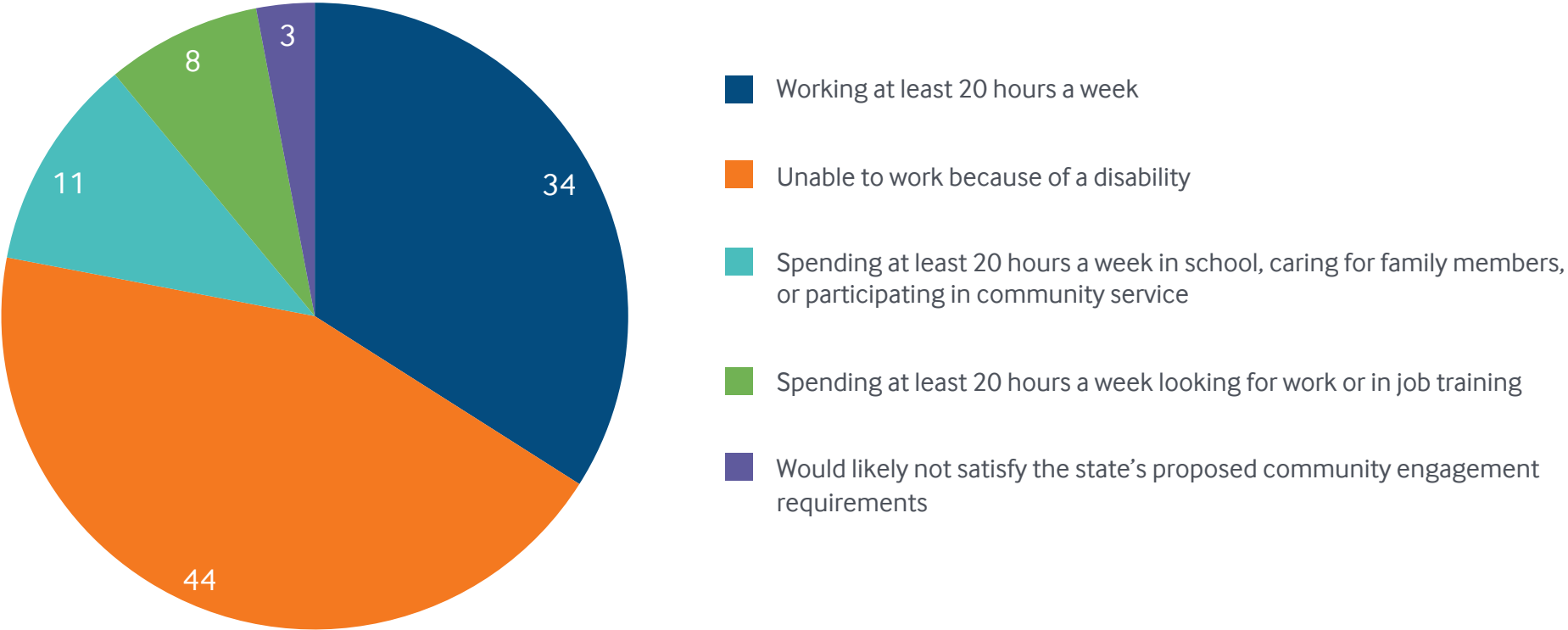
