


# Changes in Adult Medicaid Enrollment of Nonelderly Adults if All States Extended 12-Month Continuous Eligibility in 2024

### Current Law Health Coverage of the 451,000 Adults Gaining Medicaid and CHIP with 12-Month Continuous Eligibility in 2024



# Changes in Federal Spending if States Extend 12-Month Adult Continuous Eligibility in 2024 (\$ millions)





## Changes in State Spending if States Extend 12-Month Adult Continuous Eligibility in 2024 (\$ millions)




