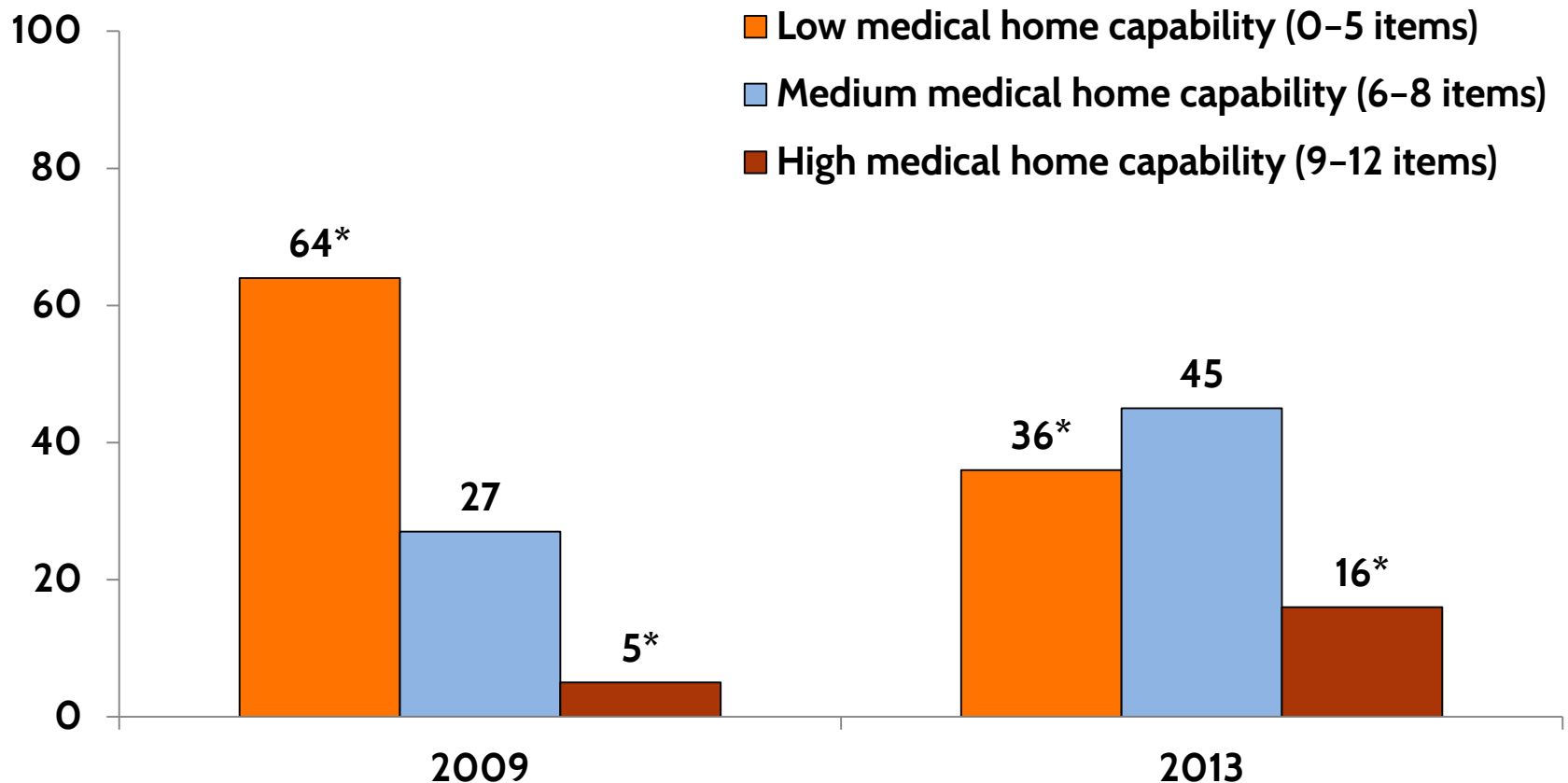


# Exhibit 1. Medical Home Capabilities Increased Among Federally Qualified Health Centers, 2009–2013

Percent of FQHCs reporting:



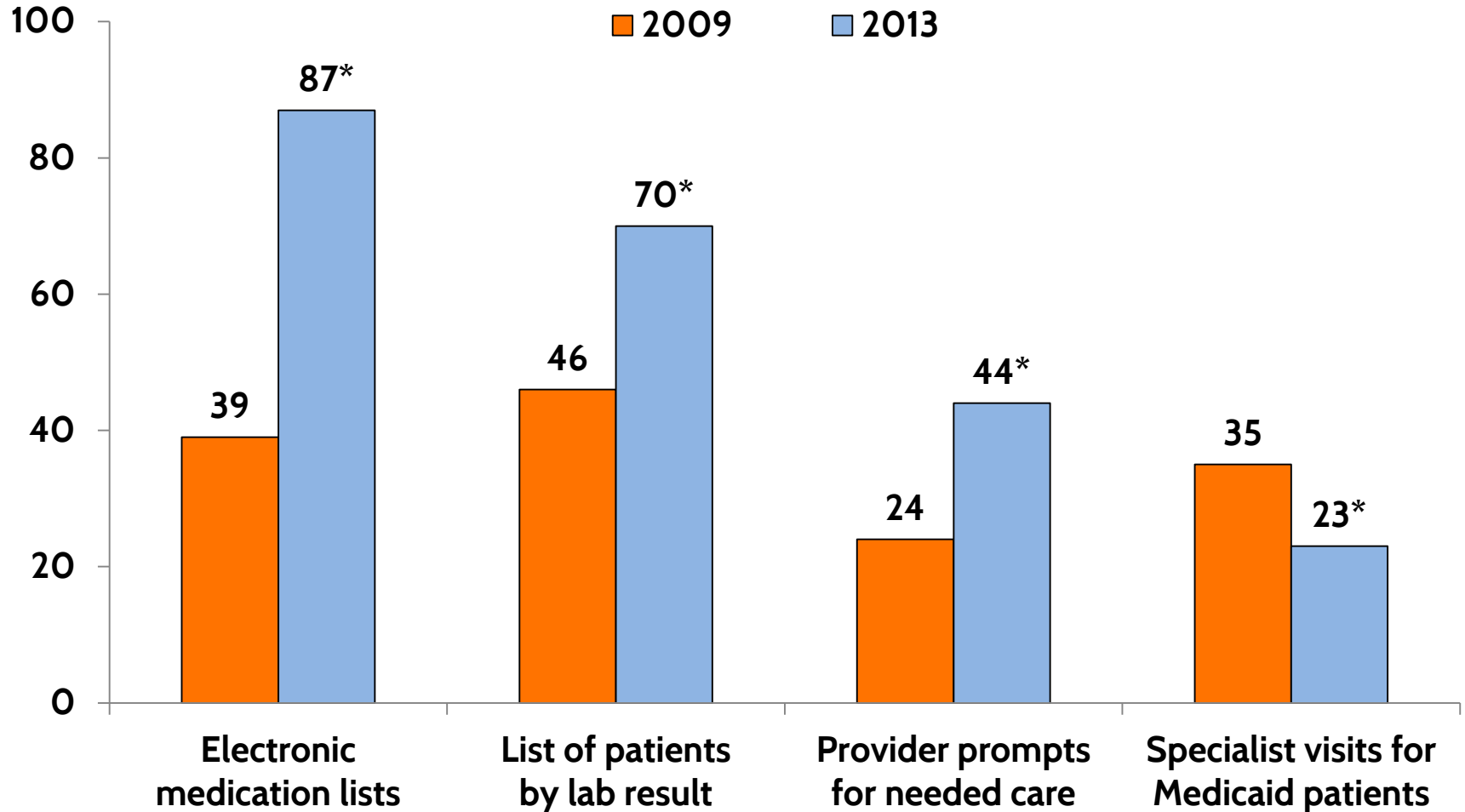

Percent of FQHCs reporting they can easily or routinely generate or obtain the following:

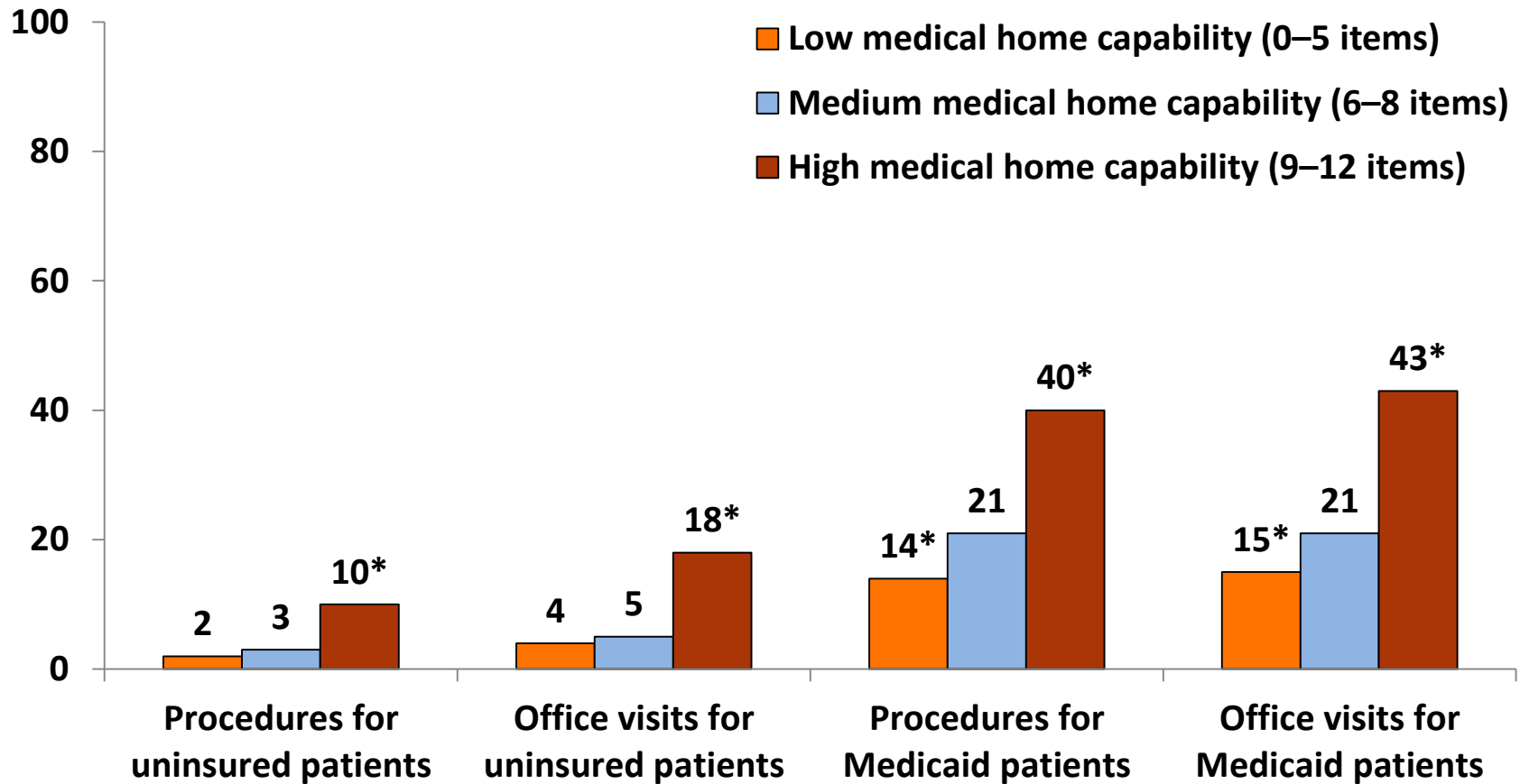
