
Medicare Beneficiaries Spending 20 Percent or More of Income on Premiums and Care, by Poverty Level

Percent of Medicare beneficiaries





Percent of Medicare beneficiaries paying 10 percent or more of income out-of-pocket on medical care alone




Medicare Beneficiaries' Out-of-Pocket Spending by Type of Health Care Service

Medicare Beneficiaries' Average Annual Out-of-Pocket Costs for Medical Care by Coverage and Health


