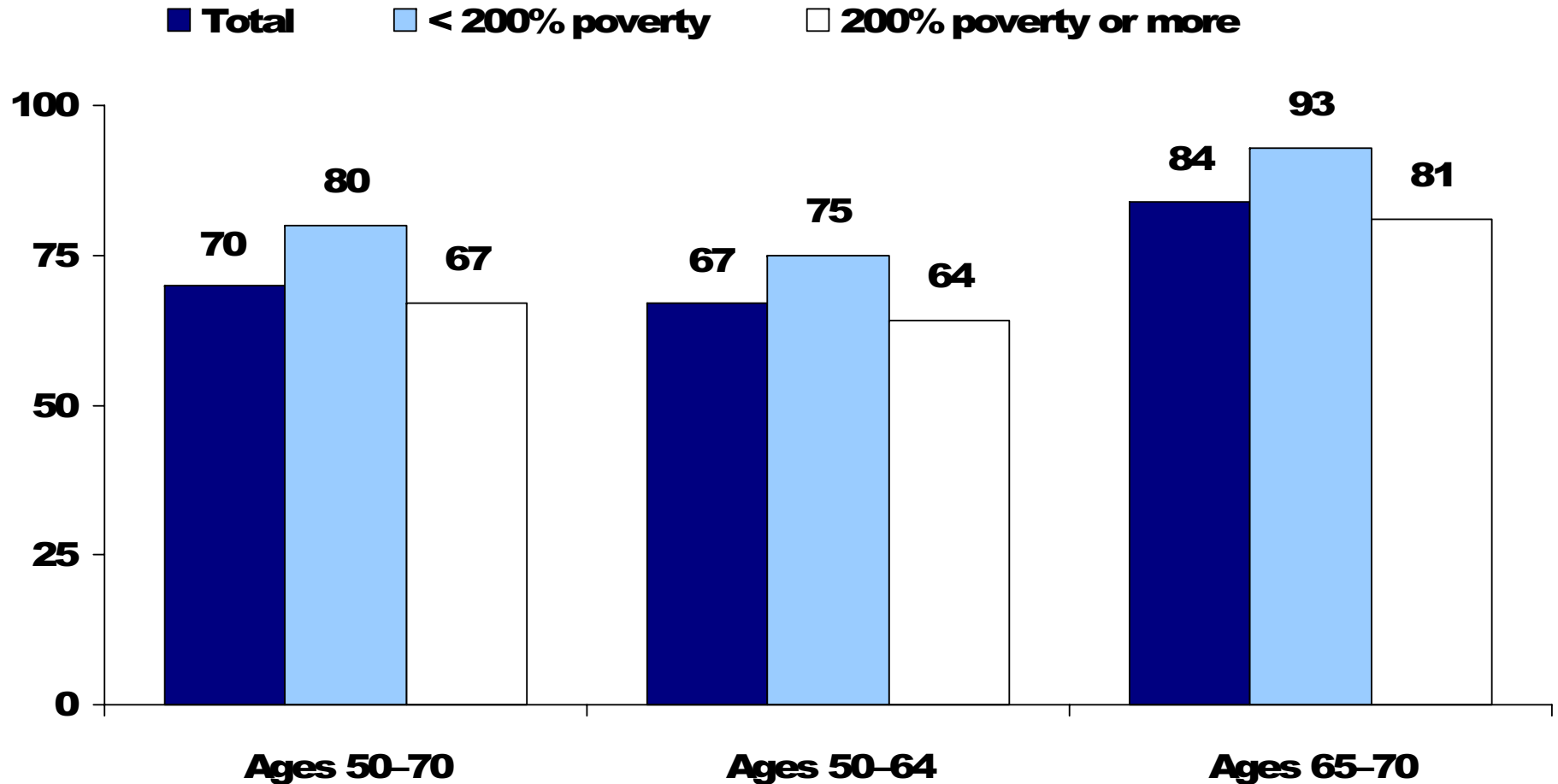


# Figure 1. Rates of Chronic Conditions Among Older Adults, by Income Level

Percent of adults with a chronic condition\*

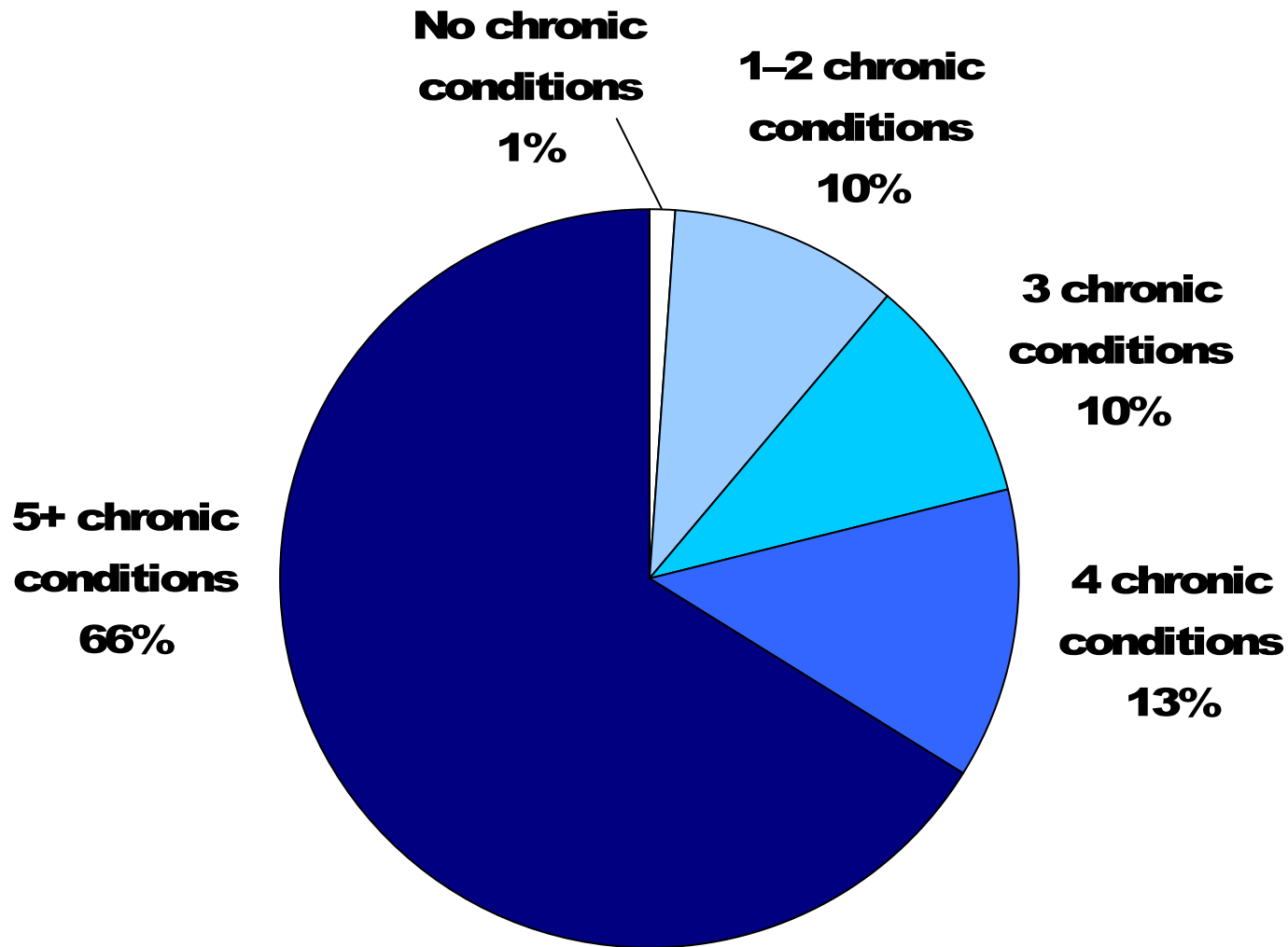

**Figure 2. Medicare Spending by Beneficiary's Number of Chronic Conditions**

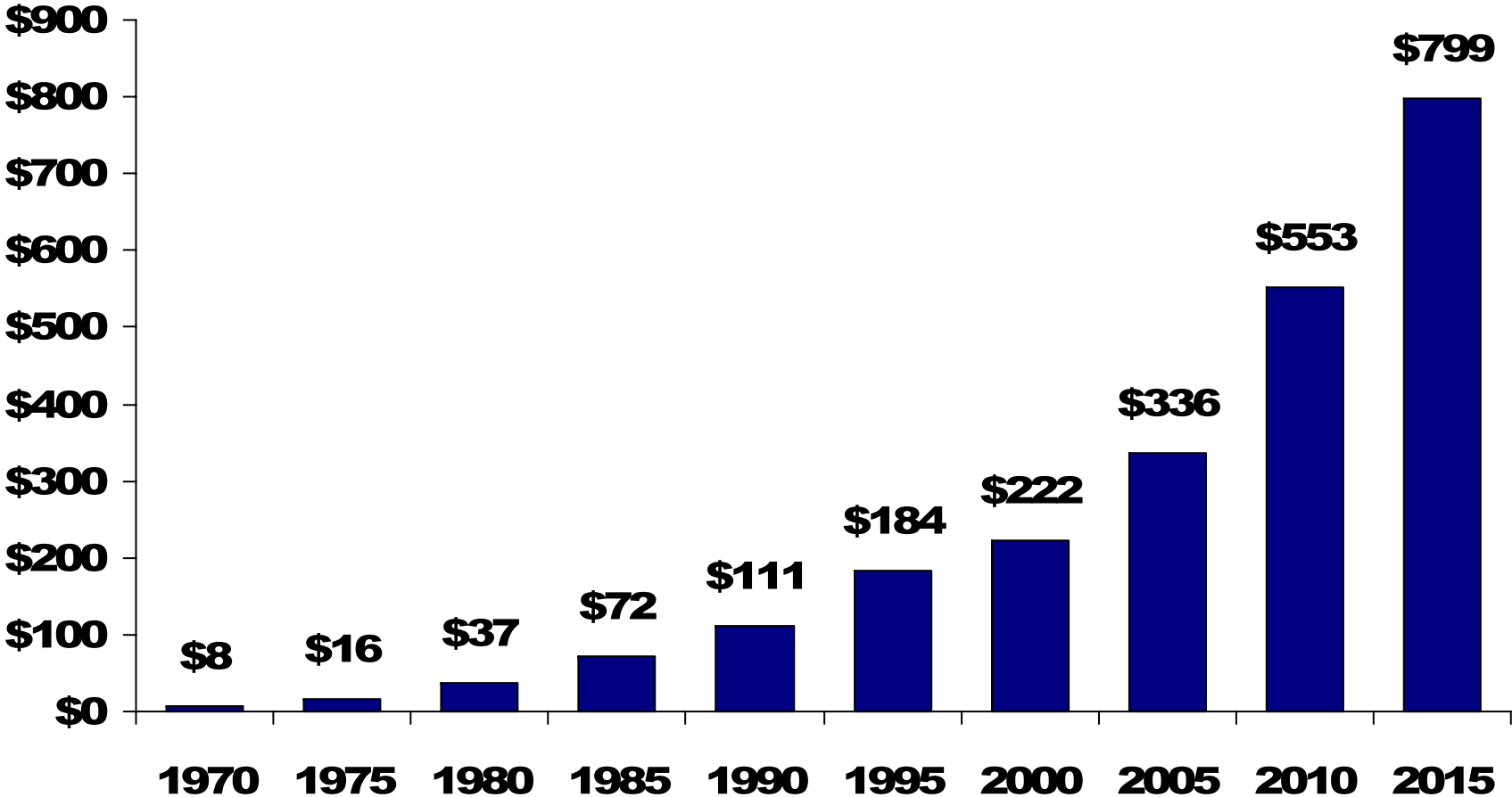

# Figure 3. Medicare Expenditures, 1970-2015

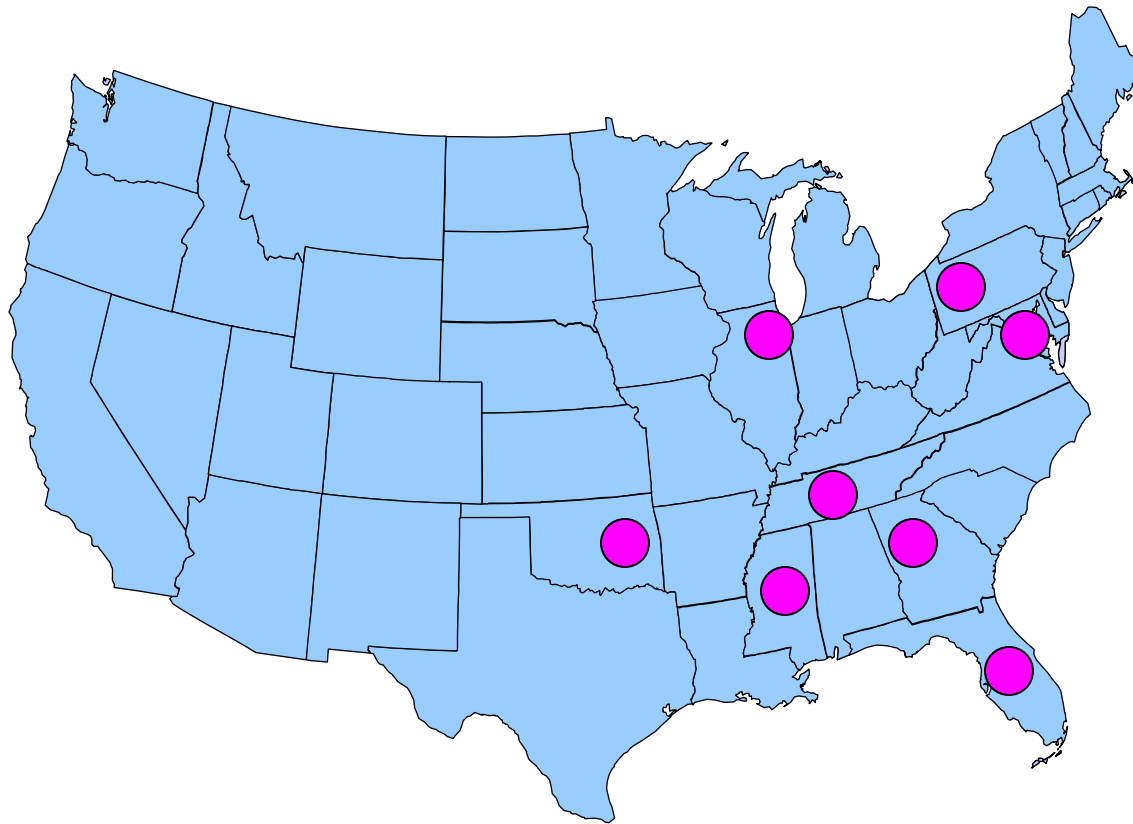
Dollars (in billions)
